Directions: After you have completed an activity, color in the tic-tac-toe board for that activity! See if you can get a tic-tac-toe by completing three activities across, down, or diagonally. For a real challenge, try to cover the whole board!

Go on a number hunt in your house. What numbers did you find and where did you find them?	Cut out 5 pictures in a magazine that have a shape. Glue them on paper and write the name of the shape next to it.	Write the digits of your phone number and the number words underneath each digit.
Illustrate pictures for the numbers that are more than 1 but less than 10	Line up 5 of your toys. Which one is first, second, etc. Draw and label.	What month is your birthday? What month comes before? After?
Write down the days of the week. Write or draw an activity that you like to do on each day.	Write the number words 1-10 using alphabet pasta, alphabet stickers, or by cutting out letters from a newspaper or magazine.	Look around your room. How many light switches do you have? What number comes before that number? What number comes after?
